IIM Jammu Orientation Program of the 3rd Batch of Ph.D., 7th Batch of MBA, 2nd Batch of EMBA, 1st Batch of MBA (HA&HM): Day Two

13th July 2022 (Wednesday): The Institute commenced its 2nd day of the 5-day Orientation Program with a peaceful yoga session that focused on the theme, 'Maximize happiness and mindfulness' by the Yoga and meditation trainer. Post the yoga session, the students were made to visit the new campus of IIM Jammu in Jagti. The students felt ecstatic when they finally got to see the campus.

The post-lunch program witnessed a parallel session for MBA, MBA (HA & HM), and Ph.D. students by Dr. Nitin Upadhyay, Chairperson, MBA, Dr. Harsha Jariwala, Chairperson MBA (HA & HM) and Dr. Vaseem Akram, Chairperson, Doctoral Program, IIM Jammu respectively.

Dr. Upadhyay, in his address to the students, shared the course structure, program pedagogy and objectives with the students.
